Matt Burns and TJ Williams, both recent college swimmers/graduates and former Team Dolphin swimmers, are returning to the Dolphins family to share their swimming experience and expertise while lending a hand to Head Coach Rob Kenley. Matt and TJ are excited to join the staff and assist Coach Kenley in working primarily with the Senior and Advanced Age Groups. Below is a brief bio for each. As you can see, Matt and TJ have solid swimming backgrounds, and the Team Dolphins staff looks forward to them giving back to our program by sharing their knowledge and enthusiasm for the sport of swimming.

Matt Burns: Matt is a graduate of the University of Missouri with a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics with an emphasis in Actuarial Science and Mathematical Finance. Matt competed for four years as a part of MU's swimming and diving team. His specialty event was sprint freestyle. His honors include Academic All-Big 12 First Team, Varsity M student-athlete of the week, and he was chosen as the hardest worker for sprint group in 2007-2008 season. Prior to swimming in college, Matt swam for Blue Springs High School where he was captain of the varsity swim team that placed 2nd at State, he broke two state records, he was a 5-time All-American, and he was All-State 9 times. As a Team Dolphin swimmer, Matt was a Junior National qualifier. His swimming career totaled 12 years.

TJ Williams: TJ is a graduate Northern Arizona University with a degree in Speech and Language Pathology with an emphasis in Special Education. She swam for Northern Arizona University for four years where she accumulated the following honors: 3-time All-WAC Swimmer, 3-time All-WAC Academic, 3-time Golden Eagle Award Winner. Prior to college, TJ also swam for Blue Springs High School. She was All-State 11 times, was a 4-time All-American, was on 3 All-American relays (one of which was 10th in the nation), and she still holds the current school and conference records in the 100 breaststroke. As a Dolphin's swimmer, TJ was a Junior National qualifier at the age of 15. She placed at Junior Nationals in the 200 breaststroke in 2005. TJ is currently working towards her Masters Degree in Speech and Language Pathology at Rockhurst University.
